

## CYC JUVENILE AND JUNIOR BASKETBALL 2019

1. Any player that is on a high school roster for 50% or more of the season is not eligible to play in a CYC league. This applies to freshmen, junior varsity and varsity rosters – even if the high school season is over.
2. CYC ID cards are required for all players and coaches. CYC cards and an approved copy of the roster should be available at all games. Teams have until the end of the game to produce these items. Teams without ID cards and roster may forfeit the game. ID Cards are available at [www.cycstl.net/id-cards](http://www.cycstl.net/id-cards). In the comment box, type “High School Player”.
3. All managers and coaches are responsible for rules and regulations within the 2019 CYC Constitution and the 2019 CYC Basketball rulebook. Both can be found at [www.cycstl.net](http://www.cycstl.net).
4. All games must start on time. A team must have five players to start the game. If the team cannot field five players after ten minutes, the game is forfeited.
5. Games will be played with 20 minute running clock halves. The clock will stop on every whistle in the last two minutes of the game, unless the winning team is up by 20 points or more. 4 timeouts per game. 5 minute warm-up between games.
6. Numbered uniform shirts of a similar color are required. Players not meeting this requirement will not be allowed to play.
7. Scoresheets/books should be filled out prior to game time.
8. Any player, coach or manager ejected from a game is suspended until the case is resolved. The team manager/coach should contact Dan Fitzgerald (314-792-7253) at the CYC Office the next work day. Ejections require a minimum of two game suspension. Three technical during the season may result in disqualification from the remaining league and playoff games.
9. This league is played under the auspices of the Catholic Church. Any vulgar or foul language; derogatory or slanderous remarks; or any unsportsmanlike conduct contrary to the CYC philosophy will not be tolerated.
10. Protest should refer to Article VII, pages 6 and 7 of the CYC Constitution. However, Juvenile/Junior teams differ insofar as all protests must be presented in writing and filed with Dan Fitzgerald by 5:00pm, the next CYC work day, along with \$50. Note: In basketball, a valid protest must be announced after the first stoppage of play.
11. There must be one adult, with a CYC ID card, on the bench for the entire game. This adult will be responsible for the teams’ actions. An adult must be 21+ years of age. If a team cannot comply with this rule, the game will not start or will be terminated if it has already started.

**NEW FOR 2019**

- In an effort to avoid the Spring Break scheduling issues, this season we will play two games before Christmas – Dec 9<sup>th</sup> and Dec 16<sup>th</sup> – and the remaining eight games in 2019. The season will be over Mar 3<sup>rd</sup>. Playoffs will be held after Spring Break.
- This means registration will be done earlier. All teams should be registered by Friday **November 30<sup>th</sup>**.
- **Any team that “no shows” a scheduled game, without proper notification, will be removed from the league with no refund.**
